



The Ultimate 2022 CPWO Experience presented by Audi™ Contest

Official Contest Rules

The Ultimate 2022 CPWO Experience presented by Audi (the “Contest”), sponsored by the Royal Canadian Golf Association operating as and hereby, “Golf Canada,” commences at 1:00pm ET on July 22, 2021 and concludes at 1:00 pm ET on August 24, 2021 (the “Contest Period”).

How to Enter:

1. Visit [contest entry form](#) to register for the 2021 CP Women’s Leadership Summit and submit the contest registration consent
2. No purchase necessary. Any active registered CP Women’s Leadership Summit participant is eligible for the Contest.

The Contest is open to all residents of Canada who have registered for the 2021 CP Women’s Leadership Summit, are 18 years of age or older at time of entry, except for employees of Golf Canada and Audi, or members of those persons’ respective immediate families, or anyone with whom any of those persons are domiciled. The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited.

The prize is subject to the conditions, restrictions, expiry dates, requirements and regulations noted on the prize certificates and applicable at the time of delivery and use. The prize is not convertible to cash and must be accepted as awarded.

A random draw for the prize will be made at the Golf Canada office in Oakville, Ontario on August 26, 2021, at 11:00am ET from all eligible entries received during the contest period. The odds of winning a prize depend on the total number of eligible entries received for the Contest during the Contest Period.

Golf Canada will attempt to contact the selected entrant via email and/or telephone for approximately one (1) week following the draw, between 9:00 am ET and 7:00 pm ET. If Golf Canada is unable to contact the selected entrant after three (3) attempts, the submission will be rendered null and void and another selected entrant will be chosen. This procedure will be repeated until a selected entrant has been contacted within the given time. In order to win the Prize, the selected entrant must have complied with the official contest rules, correctly answered the arithmetical skill-testing question to be administered by email, and sign and return Golf Canada’s standard declaration and release form which will be sent by email. The Prize will be forfeited if the declaration and release form is not returned to Golf Canada within 15 days after prize notification. The Prize must be accepted as awarded, without substitutions or transfers. Any additional costs incurred in using the Prize are a winner’s responsibility.

In the event the alternate winner does not return the required documentation within 15 days (following the procedures set forth above) the Prize will be forfeited and the procedure to award a winner will be repeated.
